3. THEORETICAL CONTRIBUTIONS (IF APPLICABLE) Does it contain relevant aspects from a theoretical point of view? Are they adequately founded? Does it review aspects relating to the status of the discipline?

4. METHODOLOGICAL QUALITY Are the method and the treatment given to the subject appropriate? And the design? The gathering of information? The exploitation of results? The techniques used? The presentation of graphs and tables? The conclusions?

5. SOURCES: Are the bibliographical references and documents used by the author up to date? What other sources should he/she have taken into account?
